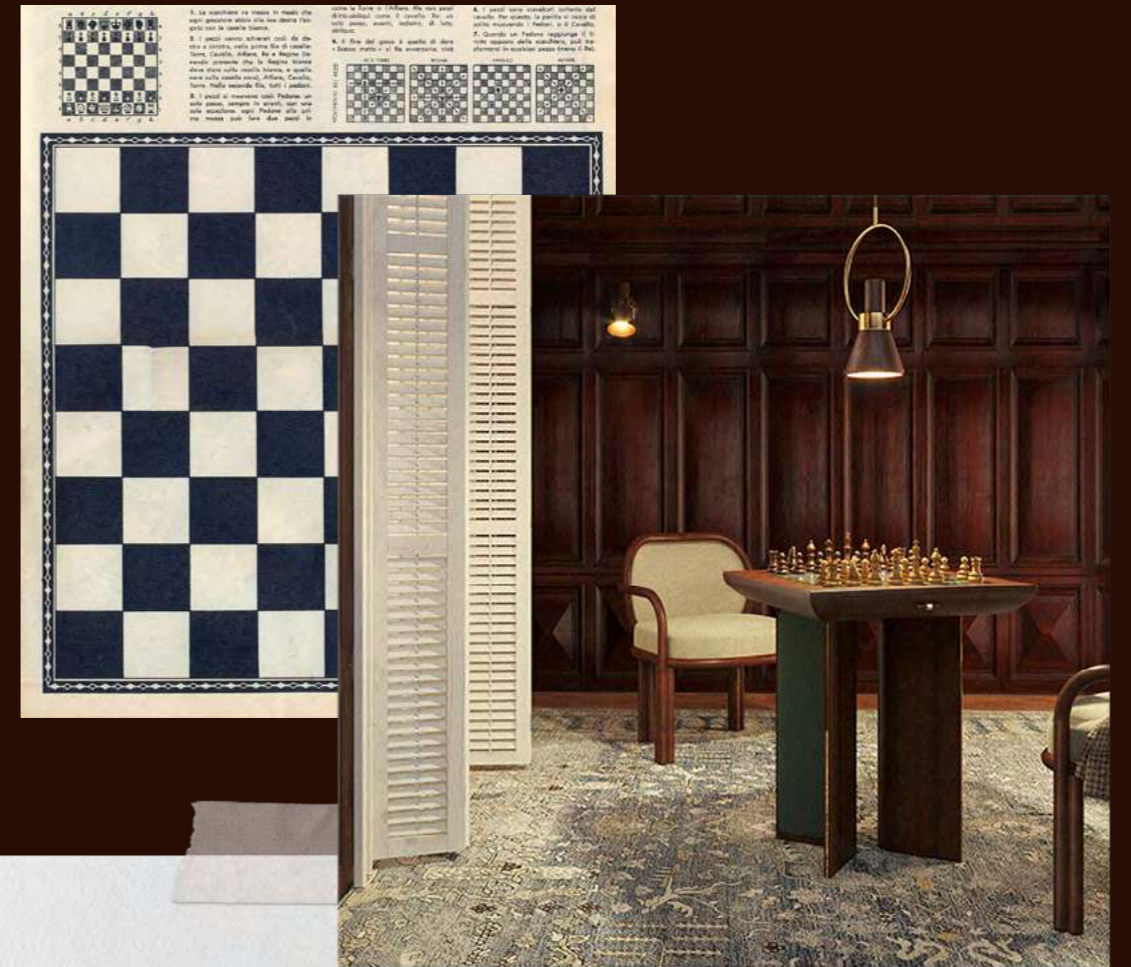


Chess is one of the most known classic strategy games. Originated in India, the history of chess goes back almost 1500 years until spread to the world.

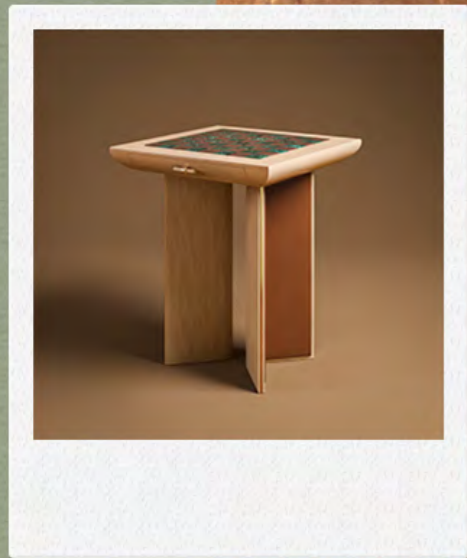
